Top Tips

- Carefully research and chose facts about your issue.
- Check that the fact come from a reliable source and is up-to-date?.

Quiz

- Be creative with your facts to make a fun and educational quiz.
- You could make a quiz in Word or PowerPoint, or perhaps an interactive quiz online (you could sign up to www.surveymonkey.com, for example).

Fact Sheet

- When you create a fact sheet, you only have one page to communicate important information on your chosen issue in a clear and simple way.
- Make it easy for people to understand your message, present your facts in a logical order.

Infographic

- An infographic is a visual representation of information. Instead of blocks of text, you give your audience the same facts in a different way — one that is more visual.
