Find a video you think really explains well the issue you are tackling, watch it, then use the facts you have learned to create an information leaflet suitable for Year 5 students.



Top Tips

- When searching for a video about your sustainability issue, make sure you check who made the video. Make sure the source is reliable and the information presented is factual.
- When creating a leaflet, you'll need a title. The title should be brief and informative, but also catch the reader's attention, inviting them to read more.
- Give an overview. An overview is a brief but clear opening that clearly states the objective of the leaflet.
- Keep it simple. Leaflets should be organised and clear to read. Use plain English and avoid slang or overly complicated sentences - remember you are creating it for Yr 5 students. Use pictures!
- Once you have all your information typed up, proofread and check for grammar, spelling and formatting errors. If you prefer, you can also write/design your leaflet by hand!
- You could ask a close friend or relative to proofread your work to check your grammar and spelling.
