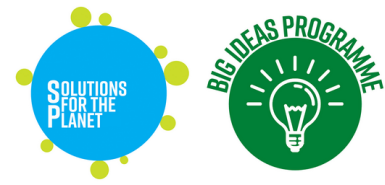

Development Session 7



OVERVIEW

Development Session 7 is for students to pull all the work they have done together - finish their Business Plans and PowerPoint slides, including any Challenge work they've done, and create their short Meet the Team video.

RESOURCES

INTRODUCTION

Start the session with students in their teams. Explain that they will be looking at the key elements of all their hard work, and what to submit. Make it clear to students that they have already done a lot of the hard work - this session is about bringing it all together and putting it into the most high-impact, concise form for the judges to see. Use the 'Bringing It All Together' handout as a guide.

The key elements to complete and submit are:

- 1) Business Plan, all sections (Challenge work incorporated if applicable)
- 2) A set of PowerPoint slides to support their business plan (Challenge and supporting work incorporated if applicable)
- 3) A 2-minute 'Meet the Teams' video (this can be uploaded separately or embedded into the PPT, and if there are permissions issues ask your Programme Coordinator for non-video options.)

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS

- This session is a chance to bring all your hard work together, see what's finished, what's missing, and what can be improved.
- Look at your business plan with your team, check you've completed ALL the sections as fully as you can. Have you explained things fully and given as many details as you can? Have any of your team members done any of the Challenge work? Could any of the information you found out for those Challenges help you improve any of your answers on the business plan? (for example they could update any questions on the business plan using the research and work that they did for the Finance Challenge, if they completed it.)
- Look at your PowerPoint slides with your team. Do they directly connect to and support your business plan? If any of your team members did any of the Challenge work, make sure you include it in the slides.
- Do you have any other supporting work? (for example, data from market research; emails sent/received; etc.). If so, gather that together too, and add to your PPT.
- There are three items to submit: 1) Completed business plans, 2) PPT slides and 3) your Meet the Team video. (They can send everything to you and you can upload all three items to a One Drive link your Programme Coordinator will send you a couple of days before the submission deadline.)

CONCLUSION

All the teams, by the end of the session, should have completed (or be ready to complete) ALL sections of their business plan and incorporated any of the Challenge work they've done, as well as put their PPT slides together (or be clear about what to include). They should have clear guidelines for their short Meet the Team video.

WHAT'S NEXT

- 1) Upload the Business Plan, PowerPoint and Meet the Team Video to a link your Programme Coordinator will send you at the beginning of the week of submission.
- 2) Hand out the 'Meet the Team Video' Tips sheet to guide the teams in the creation of their simple introductory video for the judges, which will also form part of their submission.
