

'Bringing it all together'

Guide

It's time to bring together all of your hard work so far, ready to submit it all to the Big Ideas Competition!

- 1) Update and submit your final Business Plan*
- 2) Create and submit your final PowerPoint presentation*
- 3) Record and submit a 'Meet the Team' video

*if you have completed any Challenges, include that work too, if you haven't, don't worry!



Further Information

There are **THREE** things to submit to the competition:

1) Your Business Plan

- Make sure you have completed **all sections** of the Business Plan.
- If you have completed any of the Challenges, then make sure you include what you've learned (for example you can update question 2 on the Business Plan with the research you did for Challenge 2 - Research Skills; or you can update questions 17-18 (and 19-20) on the Business Plan using the research and work that you did for Challenge 6 - Business Model and Finances).

2) Your PowerPoint

- You should update your PowerPoint to support your updated Business Plan.
- If you have completed any of the Challenges, then make sure you include your work in your final PowerPoint (for example, your Superhero from Challenge 1; photos of your prototype or storyboard from Challenge 3; details of your social media campaign from Challenge 5).
- You may also have other supporting work, for example emails you may have sent/received, data collected from market research, etc. **ADD ALL OF THIS SUPPORTING WORK TO YOUR PPT PRESENTATION.** (If you have a video or audio file that is too big to upload, then message us on the forum and we will tell you what to do.)

3) Your 'Meet the Team' video

- This year, because the Big Ideas Programme is virtual, we want to give you the opportunity to let the judges find out more about YOU, so we're asking you to submit a 2-5-minute video introducing the team. Follow the 'Meet the Team Video' Tips guide your teachers have access to in the resources section of the S4TP website.

Tips

- Remember that you've already done a lot of the hard work - this final stage is about bringing it all together and putting it into the most high-impact, concise form for the judges to see.
- Keep your PPT slides clear and simple - here are some top tips:
